<u>English</u>

In English, we are going to write a setting description and diary entry based on 'Twitch', as well as a letter in role as a character from 'The Firework Maker's Daughter'. The class will also perform a humourous poem to the school. We will be developing inference as a strategy in reading, recapping our grammar knowledge and practising a range of spelling patterns in our writing lessons.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths, we will be looking at time and mastering addition and subtraction (in various forms). These will lead us to our main focus of the term, multiplication and division, which includes the formal written methods as well as revising mental strategies. We will also be developing our reasoning and problem solving skills with all four operations.




<u>R.E.</u>
