#### **English**

This half-term we will be reading a variety of autumn and winter themed books including The Gruffalo, Stickman and The Snowman. We will be encouraging the children to write simple cvc words e.g. sat, hen, dog as well as some tricky words such as I, he, she.

**Phonics** - We will continue using the Essential Letters and Sounds programme for our daily phonics sessions. We will be focusing on recognising and writing Phase 3 sounds. An overview of these sounds/rhymes will be sent home.

#### <u>Maths</u>

In Maths, we're focusing on counting, sorting, and ordering objects and numbers up to 10 and beyond. We will explore these concepts through hands-on activities that help them recognise numbers. We'll also be singing a variety of number songs to 10.

#### P.E

Reception will continue to have P.E. on a Wednesday afternoon. All children need to have a P.E. kit in school consisting of a red P.E. t-shirt, black shorts and pumps. Please encourage your child to have a try at undressing and dressing themselves at home.



#### Reading Books

Reading as regularly as possible to an adult can really help your child progress. We would like to see your child read a minimum of FIVE times a week. Once they have read to an adult, the adult should sign their Boom reading record. Reading books are changed every Monday as long as your child's Boom Reader reading record has been signed.

This half term the children will commence guided reading sessions. Guided reading is taught daily in a small group of 6. It gives the children an opportunity to read and discuss a simple text.

### <u>R.E.</u>

This half-term, our topic is Why is Christmas Special for Christians? We'll learn that Christmas celebrates Jesus' birthday and discuss why it is an important time for Christians. Children will explore themes of love and kindness.
